Counsel for the petitioner states that though the benefits accruing to the petitioner have already been released to the petitioner during the pendency of the writ petition but the same have been released without interest as the payments were released to them after undue and unexplained delay. Counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have given the details of the payment of pensionary benefits to the petitioner in paragraph 2 of the reply but those amount do not carry the interest.

Counsel for the petitioner states that as he has not received any information from the petitioner about the payments released by them, the petitioner be given liberty to approach respondents by filing appropriate application/representation, in case any relief for which the petitioner was entitled for is still to be redressed, including the grant of interest.

The present writ petition has been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents by initiate appropriate proceedings in case any relief which the petitioner think has not been granted so far.
