GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.63 dated 4.4.2019 registered at Police Station Division B, Amritsar, District Amritsar under Sections 307, 427, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959.

The FIR was lodged at the instance of Robin Rai, wherein it has been alleged that on the day of occurrence Ankur Kahlon (@ Anterpreet Singh) (petitioner) fired a shot from his pistol hitting Rajat Kumar in his abdomen. Tejpreet Singh is alleged to have fired from his pistol hitting the complainant on his left wrist.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that infact the FIR came to be lodged under some mistaken belief and that the

misunderstandings have now been resolved and the parties have effected a compromise. The learned counsel, in this context, has referred to an affidavit (Annexure P-1) furnished by the injured Rajat Kumar, wherein he has categorically deposed therein that none of the accused was seen on the day of occurrence at the spot and that none of the accused had fired any shot at him.

Although, the learned State counsel has expressed that there is nothing on the police file to indicate any such compromise but the learned counsel for the petitioner has today shown an original affidavit furnished by injured Rajat Kumar, a copy whereof has been annexed with the petition.

Rajat Kumar is also present in person, who has been identified by ASI Gurmeet Singh. The aforesaid Rajat Kumar present in the Court has also endorsed the factum of compromise and has stated that he has no objection in case the petitioner is granted bail.

In view of the aforestated position and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is accepted and the petitioner Ankur Kahlon (@ Anterpreet Singh) is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands accepted accordingly.
