This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to adjust the petitioner as Class IV employee in some other Society/Association functioning under the control of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur, dated 03.08.2016, wherein, it has been stated that “So as per the orders of the Hon'ble Court the directions have been issued to the Block Development & Panchayat Officer Gurdaspur vide letter No.3535 dated 27/7/2016 to issue job card under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme to the petitioner for employment.....”

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if the instant petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid offer.

Learned State counsel is not averse to the submission put forth by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the assertion in the affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur, dated 03.08.2016, with a further direction to the respondents to issue job card to the petitioner if the same is not issued so far. The necessary exercise be completed within four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment.
