Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.58 dated 29.05.2019, registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 294, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Section 325 of the IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the allegations, the present petitioner was armed with a small sword/*kirpan* and gave simple injury on the head of the injured. In the present case, the doctor has not declared any injury as dangerous to life.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no injury has been declared as dangerous to life and the injury attributed to the present petitioner is simple one. Therefore, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody and then to keep him in custody till the final disposal of the case. Finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
