The prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to release refund of ₹2,86,21,762/- alongwith interest as determined vide Assessment Order dated 26.12.2014 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned State counsel submitted that necessary relief has been granted inasmuch as refund of VAT has been paid to the petitioner-company.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a copy of the communication received from the petitioner informing him that the petitioner has received the VAT refund and that there is no grievance with the Department-respondent No.2 subsisting now. Accordingly, request for withdrawal of the said writ petition was made.

4. Consequently, the said writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
