This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.PC seeking regular bail in FIR No.100 dated 11.11.2017 under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC (Sections 302, 201, 376-A, 376-D and 120-B IPC as well as Sections 4 to 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 added later on) registered at Police Station Phase-8, District Mohali.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, states that out of total 36 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 23 witnesses have been examined before the trial Court.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. October 18, 2019, there was no representation

on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
