The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as well as other members of family against the illegal action on the false and frivolous application given by respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.4 Sukhwinder Singh had made a false complaint against the petitioners which was duly inquired by the police and found to be false and the Deputy Superintendent of Police recommended that the complaint be filed. Learned counsel has submitted that despite the aforesaid inquiry, report (Annexure P-2), respondent No.4 has been threatening the petitioners.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without making any expression as regard merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation Annexure P-2 expeditiously, in accordance with law. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-2 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
