Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 177 dated 1.11.2018 under Sections 379-A (deleted later on) and Sections 395/201 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant was working as an agent in Bharat Financial Inclusion Company, which gives house loans to the ladies and the same was to be repaid in installments and for the purpose of collecting the weekly installments, on 1.11.2018, he went and collected an amount of Rs.1.67 lacs and then went to the house of one Asha, who refused to give the installment and an altercation took place.

Later on, nine persons intercepted the motorcycle and by giving him injuries, they took the bag containing the cash and the keys of the motorcycle and ran away.

Out of the accused persons, produced in the group has been identified as Ramesh, Sandeep, Rohit and Rahul @ Monu-petitioner.

Learned State counsel, has stated that the bail application of Ramesh and Rohit, who were also identified by PW1 stands dismissed as withdrawn vide orders 28.8.2019 and 3.9.2019 passed in CRM-M-28597-2019 and CRM-M-34821-2019, respectively.

In view of the same and considering the serious allegations against the petitioner and also in view of the fact that the petitioner was duly identified by the complainant, I find no ground to grant the bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
