Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.4, who in connivance with respondent No.3 SHO, Police Station Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur is pressurising the petitioner to get the matter compromised and in the event of not acting on it, to face dire consequences in FIR No.2 dated 09.01.2019 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the paper book, it reveals that in the representation dated 23.05.2019 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner to Senior Superintendent of Police,

Ferozpur, though in the head note of the prayer, the petitioner had prayed for protection of life and liberty, but in the last paragraph of the representation, he had prayed for arrest of the accused and to transfer the investigation to another police station or some higher police official. No such material has been placed on record to substantiate his allegations as projected in the present petition. The FIR in question was registered on 09.01.2019 and it is but presumed that the same is under investigation. Therefore, this Court finds no ground to interfere in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
