The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioner and other members of his family by calling them repeatedly to the police Station.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Khanna (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2), moved by petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law. It is further directed that in case the petitioner is required to be associated in connection with any inquiry or any information

is required to be elicited from him, then an advance notice in terms of Section 160 Cr.P.C. be afforded to him.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-2 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Khanna (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
