The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondent No.2 to take appropriate action against private respondent No.3 on the application dated 07.05.2019 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that respondent No.3 is husband of the petitioner and is working with the police department as ASI. He is harassing the petitioner for dowry. The petitioner has been given beating on 08.04.2019 for which she had to take treatment from Rajindra Hospital, Patiala, but despite injuries on her person, no case has been registered against the petitioner.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior

Superintendent of Police, Patiala to consider the application dated 07.05.2019 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of respondent No.3, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the contents of application (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law.
