The petitioner has sought direction to the respondents
to sanction and grant her the old age pension from 08.09.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to
explain that the income of the husband of the petitioner is less than two
lakh after deducting interest and other benefits in the relevant year
2014 and the petitioner is eligible for grant of pension.

In pursuance to the complaint lodged by the
petitioner, an inquiry was conducted into the matters of persons who
were alleged to be not eligible and on inquiry, the pension was
discontinued with regard to ineligible persons as reflected in inquiry
report (Annexure R-6). Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

As per reply, after inquiry, 46 persons nominated by the petitioner in Annexure R-6 have been found to be ineligible, therefore, respondent No.1 is directed to take necessary action as per law against the officials involved in the process of allowing pension to ineligible persons and the action taken report in this regard be sent to the Registrar General of this Court.
