GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to lodge FIR for offence under Section 420, 448, 506 read with Section 34 of IPC against respondents No.4 to 7 as they have committed an offence of house trespass and have taken illegal possession of the house of the petitioner who is 90 years old person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is aged 90 years and that although the petitioner has made a representation dated 15.6.2018 (Annexure P-1) to the police but no action had been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without making any expression as regard merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, District Nuh (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to ensure that the representation Annexure P-1 is disposed of expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
