TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the respondent passport authorities to carry out a correction in her passport as regards her date of birth and for the same to read as 20.05.1957 instead of 01.01.1957.

In support of the prayer made in the petition documents at Annexure P-2(Colly) in the nature of Aadhar Card, PAN Card and a Senior Citizen Identity Card have been appended.

Counsel submits that a representation in such regard dated 22.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) has already been submitted but the same is still pending consideration. Prayer has been made that he would be satisfied if the said representation was to be disposed of with a direction to the concerned authority to decide the same within a stipulated time frame.

Notice of motion.

Ms.Sonia Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court,

accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

A complete copy of the writ paper-book already stands furnished to counsel opposite.

Ms.Sharma makes a statement that in case the representation dated 22.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) regarding correction of date of birth of the petitioner is pending with the respondent authorities, the same would be processed in accordance with law and a final decision thereupon would be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today.

Statement of the counsel representing the respondents is accepted.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition disposed of.
