Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of DDR No.38 dated 24.01.2019, under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur in FIR No. 10 dated 24.01.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise between the parties.

Vide order dated 04.07.2019, this Court has directed the parties to appear before Illaqa Magistrate on 14.10.2019 for recording their statements and directed the Illaqa Magistrate to submit the report on this behalf.

Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moonak has submitted a report to this Court and it has been stated in the report that there are four accused in the

compromise appears to be genuine and voluntary and without any question and undue influence and that as per the statement of IO accused was not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the State has no objection in case the DDR is quashed as offences under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC.

Thus, following the judgment in Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, as well as Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303, this petition is allowed and DDR No.38 dated 24.01.2015 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise.
