Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the official respondents no.1 and 2 to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 10 and who are stated to be acting in connivance and through respondent no.3, who happens to be the S.H.O, Police Station, Dirba, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and the pleadings on record have been perused.

Averments in the petition would reveal that respondent no.6 is none other than the wife of the petitioner. The matrimonial relations between the parties are strained. The other private respondents are close blood relations of respondent no.6.

In para 5 of the petition it has been averred that proceedings for maintenance have already been initiated by respondent no.6 and in which a charge had been created on the property of the petitioner.

Counsel clearly concedes that an amount of Rs.2,000/- per month is being paid by the petitioner to respondent no.6 towards maintenance.

In para 6 of the petition it has been averred that the petitioner has already instituted a suit for permanent injunction against the private respondents for forcible possession of his property to be not taken and in which a status quo order has already been passed by the Civil Court on 21.6.2019.

Clearly there are proceedings already pending before the competent court inter se the parties.

The present petition is nothing but a fall out of a bad marriage.

The averments in the petition do not bring out any realistic threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

No intervention is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
