Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact the matter has been compromised between him and the complainant in the FIR, i.e. Devinder Kaur, with a copy of the compromise deed having been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

He further submits that CRM-M-23390 of 2019 has also been filed before this Court seeking quashing of the FIR itself on the basis of the said compromise.

As per the custody certificate filed in Court today by the learned State counsel, the petitioner is in custody for the last 3 months and 12 days, with no other case seen to be registered against him.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The

petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
