GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.19 dated 08.04.2018 under Sections 406/498-A IPC, Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties
2. Vide order dated 10.07.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Sofia @ Sofia Sehdev have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant

has no objection if the FIR is quashed . It has specifically been opined by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar that the compromise effected between the complainant and accused is genuine and without any pressure or undue influence.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.19 dated 08.04.2018 under Sections 406/498-A IPC, Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
