Learned counsel for the respondents states that in the present writ petition, the challenge is to the charge-sheet dated 10.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) and prayer is for the release of the pensionary benefits which were withheld after the retirement of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents on the instructions from Senior Assistant Inderjit Singh, states that during the pendency of the writ petition, an order was passed on 22.02.2017 by which the charge-sheet was dropped and thereafter, all the benefits for which, petitioner was entitled, were released to the petitioner on 24.05.2017. Counsel for the respondents further states that no other benefit for which the petitioner is entitled, is still pending to be paid to the petitioner.

No one is present on behalf of petitioner to rebut the statement. Even though, the counsel for petitioner had taken time on the last date of hearing to verify the same statement made on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the claim of the petitioner, as raised in the present writ

petition, does not survive any further. In case, the petitioner has any grievance left, he will be at liberty to file a representation with the respondents to claim the same.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in case, any claim is raised by the petitioner by filing any representation including the grant of interest, the same will be considered in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of three months from the receipt of the said representation.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of.
