KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE: (Oral)

This petition has been filed, seeking following main relief:-

“Issuance of a writ of appropriate nature particularly Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and decide the application (25.01.2018 diarised on 6.2.2018)/representations dated 15.02.2018 diarised on 19.02.2018 and dated 5.03.2018 made by the petitioners for grant of extension from Ateli to Narnaul in their existing route permits pending with them (Annexure P-2 to P-4). The request of the petitioners is permissible under Section 80(3) of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. It is also prayed to issue ad interim direction to the respondents to allow the petitioners to operate their buses upto Narnaul temporarily till the pendency of the writ petition/representation.”
