The petitioners have challenged the order dated 03.06.2019 by which they have been asked to vacate the land in question. The said order has been passed pursuant to the orders passed by the Collector and the Commissioner respectively under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short “the Act”) by which the respondents therein have been ordered to be evicted. Thus, until and unless, orders of eviction are not challenged, in accordance with law, order dated 03.06.2019 cannot be challenged by the petitioner because it is an off shoot of those two orders.

Faced with above observations, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to challenge the orders passed under Section 7 of the Act as well in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.
