The petitioner is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner and restraining them from terminating the services of petitioner, without following due process of law.

2. Further prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, to quash the letter dated 11.02.2011 (Annexure P-5) and to grant balance salary and other benefits as applicable to her.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the writ petition is rendered infructuous in view of the order dated 19.01.2018 (Annexure R-10), vide which the impugned order dated 11.02.2011 (Annexure P-5) has been withdrawn during the

pendency of writ petition.

4. After perusal of the order dated 19.01.2018 (Annexure R-10), I am in agreement with the said submission of learned counsel for the respondents. As regards relief of issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to restrain the respondents from terminating the services of petitioner without following due process of law, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case any such action is contemplated then the services of petitioner shall not be terminated, without following the due process of law.

5. As regards the regularization of the petitioner, the order dated 19.01.2018 itself states that the same are governed/regulated by Directorate of Accounts Circular List. Let a decision qua the same be taken by the respondents in accordance with the said Directorate of Accounts Circular List, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
