The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.92, dated 08.05.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 506 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were unarmed and it is alleged that petitioner No.1 has slapped the complainant while petitioner No.2 has threatened the complainant.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 08.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 08.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
