Despite the case having been called out in the pre lunch session as well as post lunch session, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana states that as against the claim for appointment on compassionate basis, the petitioner has been granted relief as admissible under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees (Amendment) Rules, 2006 i.e financial assistance w.e.f 1.8.2016 to 31.7.2031 vide Annexure R-3/T and that in view thereof, the writ petition has become infructuous.

In view of the statement of learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the case in case any cause of action survives.
