Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.155 dated 04.12.2018 registered under Sections 379-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station E Division Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner was nominated as accused on the statement of Mandeep Singh, a co-accused. He further submits that first informant has already been examined and was got declared hostile by the Public Prosecutor. He further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 05.12.2018 and he is not involved in any other case.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, has submitted that no doubt, first informant-

victim was declared hostile, however, she had identified the petitioner at the time of Test Identification Parade as well as in the Court.

Be that as it may. The petitioner is in custody since 05.12.2018. Allegations are with regard to snatching of ear rings. Petitioner is young boy of 21 years of age, not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
