During the pendency of the writ petition challenging the award dated 31.07.2015 (Annexure P/4) rejecting the reference, a settlement has been arrived at between the petitioner-workman and the management. Learned counsel for the management has placed on record original of the settlement deed dated 16.07.2018. The same is taken on record and copy thereof has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The same has been verified by the learned counsel for the parties. As per settlement, the petitioner has agreed to receive ₹75,000/- as one time settlement towards all disputes and claims against the respondent-management M/s Sandhar Camma Components Pvt. Ltd.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the matter having been compromised amongst the parties, the petitioner does not want to press the writ petition.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. Terms of the settlement deed be read as part and parcel of this order.
