In case, an official of the petitioner-College is required, he may be allowed to put up his case with relevant documents. Thereafter, after verifying the documents, the necessary action be taken in accordance with law. It is also made clear that the issue involved in the present petition is nothing to do with affiliation. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with direction to respondent-University to take action on the issue of affiliation.
