In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioners is that though the petitioners are entitled for revision of their pay scale in pursuance to the order passed in **CWP No.25733 of 2012 titled as 'A.P. Sharma and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 22.10.2013**, the respondents have not taken any step to grant the said benefit to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that though at one point of time, the case of the petitioners was recommended by the respondents-department to the Accountant General, Punjab for the grant of the benefit, as petitioners are entitled under **A.P. Sharma's case (supra)** but the objection which was raised by the office of Accountant General, Punjab is not being removed by the respondents without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already approached the respondents by filing representations, which have been appended as Annexure P-4 (Colly.) dated 01.08.2018 and thereafter, on 19.11.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner as raised in the representations collectively attached as (Annexure P-4) dated 01.08.2018 and 19.11.2018 by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representations collectively attached as (Annexure P-4) dated 01.08.2018 and 19.11.2018, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations collectively attached as (Annexure P-4) dated 01.08.2018 and 19.11.2018 within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
