Petitioner seeks a Mandamus directing the official respondents to protect his life and liberty as also his family members by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 8.

Counsel submits that an agreement to sell had been entered into between the parties and the private respondents having resiled from the contract, petitioner had instituted a suit for specific performance. The suit is stated to be still pending before the competent court.

It has been averred in paras 6 and 7 of the petition that private respondents are openly issuing threats to the petitioner to withdraw his suit failing which he would be eliminated.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.3. i.e. the S.H.O., Police Station, Ajnala, District Amritsar as regards his threat perception. In the eventuality of any such application being filed, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps, if any, and as deemed fit.
