Challenge in the instant writ petition is to the order dated 26.03.2013 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Collector, Kurukshetra and in terms of which the petitioners have been called upon to deposit the deficient stamp duty and registration fee amounting to Rs.3,28,313/-. Further challenge is to the order dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala affirming the order passed by the Collector, Kurukshetra.

Mr. R.S. Budhwar, learned Advocate representing the petitioners makes a statement at bar that he has instructions not to pursue the instant writ petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

In the light of the submissions made by counsel, writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to mention that the interim protection granted by this Court vide order dated 02.06.2017 would cease to operate.
