The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 1.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.21104 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Bhawan, Sector-5, Panchkula to consider and decide the application dated 25.5.2018 (Annexure P-6) in the light of Annexure P-5 within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within

a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

As per order dated 1.10.2018, the respondents had to decide the application of the petitioner within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

Though the time period has already elapsed, at this stage still another opportunity is provided to the respondent to do the needful within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of failure, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and the revival would be at the cost and responsibility of the respondents.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
