Concededly, petitioner failed in the written test for the post of Assistant Professor (College Cadre) Hindi under Eligible Sports Person (ESP) category.

It is also alleged that the petitioner's case is covered by the judgment dated 22.03.2017 rendered in Kuldeep Nara Versus Haryana Public Service Commission and others. On going through the contents of the aforementioned judgment, it is deciphered that the case of other set of petitioners was rejected on account of not possessing the requisite qualification, therefore, there cannot be any parity.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his case is required to be sent for consideration even if he failed in the written test. No provisions of any eligibility or educational qualification has been pointed out to the court that a person who has even failed in the written test can fall within the zone of consideration on three occasions.

In my view, the writ petition is wholly atrocious and fallacious.

The same is dismissed with costs of ₹ 10,000/- to be deposited in the welfare account of the Bar Association, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh.
