The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to
renew his passport.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the
petitioner is involved in three FIRs mentioned in paragraph No.1 of the
preliminary objections. To know the status of the said FIRs, letter dated
06.12.2017 (Annexure R-2) was sent to the petitioner which was not
replied to whereas, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that the
letter dated 06.12.2017 (Annexure R-2) was never received by him.
However, he has circulated the required information by way of
representation dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P-6).

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits
of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to pass a fresh order after

considering the representation dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P-6). The necessary order be passed within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
