The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 9.7.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 16257 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above position, this petition, at this stage is disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, by giving a direction to respondent No. 3 to 6 to look in to the legal notice dated 20.5.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If respondent Nos. 3 to 6 come to a conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the amount mentioned above, the same be released forthwith.”

As per order dated 9.7.2018, the respondents had to decide the legal notice of the petitioner within a period of one month from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

Though the time period has already elapsed, at this stage still another opportunity is provided to the respondents to do the needful within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of failure, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and the revival would be at the cost and responsibility of the respondents.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
