1. This order of mine shall dispose of bunch of six petitions, mentioned above, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that representation(s) of some of the petitioners are still pending with the respondents, while those of some of the petitioners have already been rejected. The case of petitioners is covered by the judgment dated 29.11.2018 rendered by this Court in CWP No.

1013 of 2017 titled as "*Balvir Singh v. PSPCL and another*". These petitions can be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take a decision in view of the judgment, *ibid*.

3. In the premise, the writ petitions are disposed of with directions to the respondents to take proper decision on the pending representation(s) of the petitioner(s) in terms of the judgment, *ibid*. The cases of those petitioners, whose representations have already been rejected, shall also be re-considered by the respondents afresh in light of the same judgment.

4. Let the needful be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. All the writ petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
