Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 09.05.2019 under Sections 7, 7-A, 8 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Tejinder Pal Singh, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.
