ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner herein has impugned order of his termination dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-8), vide which his services were dispensed with.

2. At the outset, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondents, under instructions, submits that the said impugned order shall be withdrawn, subject to the proposed departmental proceedings which are contemplated against the petitioner. He further submits that preliminary ground of the petitioner was that the impugned order has been passed without following the due process in accordance with law.

3. As a consequence of the proposed withdrawal of the impugned order dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-8), the writ petition would be rendered infructuous.

4. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the proposed departmental proceedings must be in accordance with law, as envisaged under the University Regulations/Rules and petitioner is also entitled to all consequential benefits, which arises consequent upon the withdrawal of the impugned order.

5. Be that as it may, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to grant all consequential benefits to the petitioner as per his entitlement, which arise consequent to the withdrawal of the impugned order dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-8). Respondents are at liberty to proceed qua the contemplated proceedings, in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders on the outcome thereof.

6. The consequential benefits,if any, due to the petitioner arising from withdrawal of impugned order dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-8), be disbursed to him within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
