The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 11.04.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross- version. He also contends that petitioner No.2 had also suffered head injury, which was declared to be grievous.

This Court, by order dated 23.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Narayan Gaur, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 23.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
