AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 29.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 30089 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 15.9.2016 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.”

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 20.8.2019. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition, however, she seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 20.8.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
