The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case No.45 of 2018 dated 23.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) filed under Sections 16, 17, 17-A, 17-B and 18-B, punishable under Sections 27/28-A of the Drug and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

On 11.07.2019, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and face the proceedings, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion for 31.07.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 11.07.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail

This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 11.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
