The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 61 dated 05.09.2018, registered under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 427, 380, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 09.07.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated 03.05.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.17690 of 2019, vide which anticipatory bail was granted to co-accused namely Sukhraj Singh. It is further submitted that the complainant is the son-in-law of the petitioner whereas an FIR No.100 dated 02.06.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran was already registered against the complainant and his other family members and the present FIR is the counter-blast of FIR No.100 dated 02.06.2018.

Notice of motion for 30.07.2019.”

The Investigating Officer ASI Major Singh, who is present in Court, submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 09.07.2019, has joined the investigation and he is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 09.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
