Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner- Jagjit Singh alias Jagga son of Pal Singh in case F.I.R. No.12 dated 16.02.2019 under Section 379-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kacha Pakka, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel representing petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 16.02.2019 and as per prosecution itself, it was a case of no injury at all to anybody; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sewak Singh, affirmed the period of detention of the petitioner.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 16.02.2019 and the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Jagjit Singh alias Jagga, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
