Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 05.09.2018 under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 427, 380, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 12.07.2019: -

“... It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that there is a matrimonial dispute between the sister of the petitioners and her husband/complainant and on that account, they have been falsely implicated in the present FIR. It is also submitted that on an earlier occasion, an FIR No.100 dated 02.06.2018 registered

under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B IPC was registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran, against the complainat party....”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravi Shankar and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 12.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
