Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for direction to the official respondents to properly investigate the matter, in FIR No.77 dated 03.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Vinod Shankar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, District Kaithal already filed in the Registry of this Court, is taken on record.

Paragraph-3 of the Preliminary Submissions of the same reveals that after investigation in the matter, report under Section 173 (2) of Cr. P.C. was prepared on 29.05.2019 and presented the same

before the Court of competent jurisdiction, on 14.06.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ragubir Singh, has also apprised the Court that after consideration of matter, charges were framed on 09.10.2019 and now the trial is pending for recording of prosecution evidence, on 17.02.2020.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to him before the learned trial Court, if so advised.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
