This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.125, dated 15.05.2019 under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

As per the Order dated 08.07.2019, learned counsel had sought an adjournment to produce some documentary evidence, showing that the present petitioner had returned the amount of earnest money to the complainant qua the earlier agreement to sell, which was entered into by the present petitioner only; before her brother had entered into a subsequent agreement and further to show that the earnest money of the complainant, qua the agreement with the present petitioner; was not adjusted towards subsequent agreement with the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been able to show any document to him to the above effect.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
