ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

By this order CRM-M-28703-2019 and CRM-M-28728-2019
shall stand disposed of.

In both the petitions, prayer is for release of the petitioners
(single petitioner in each case) on regular bail in FIR No.41 dated
22.02.2019 under Sections 307/427/34 IPC and Section 25/27/54 of the
Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Police
Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) in both the cases have

submitted that the parties have already settled their dispute and prayer for quashing of the FIR has been made in CRM-M-18480 of 2019.

Learned counsel appearing for the victim/complainant does not dispute this position.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, submits that investigations are over and challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the parties have already settled their dispute, therefore, the petitioners in both the petitions are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
