Grievance of the petitioners is that they have not been accorded the benefit of 'Assured Career Progression Scheme', as contemplated under instructions/circular dated 21.06.2000 (Annexure P-3). In the premise, the petitioners also caused legal notice dated 24.05.2019 (Annexure P-4), which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, no further proceedings or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the legal notice dated 24.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) along with the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation, as also keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners, as noted above, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are found entitled to the benefit as prayed for, the same be granted to them within two months of the passing of the appropriate orders.
