Instant petition has been filed seeking a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents no.4 to 8.

It has been averred that the petitioners had entered into matrimony against the wishes of the elders and had run away to the State of Uttar Pradesh to make a living.

The necessity of filing the present petition has arisen as the petitioners want to come to their permanent place of living which falls in district Gurugram and they apprehend that the close relatives of the girl i.e. petitioner no.1 would cause some bodily harm as threats have been issued.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach respondent no.3 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station, Farukh Nagar, district Gurugram confined to the aspect of protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

In the eventuality of any such application being made, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
