The case set out in present petition is that in pursuance to advertisement, Annexure P-1, process of filling up 61 posts of Junior Engineer (Civil) (re-advertised), by way of direct recruitment was initiated. Essential qualification for the said post was Diploma in Civil Engineer or equivalent or knowledge of Hindi/Sanskrit upto Matric Standard or Higher Education. The petitioner being fully eligible submitted online application alongwith academic qualifications, was issued a Roll No.7172801171. Examination was held on 09.04.2018 to 11.04.2018 and was shortlisted for scrutiny of documents to be held on 10.06.2019 and 17.06.2019. However, petitioner was not able to go for scrutiny of documents as roll number slip was lost. Respondent No.3 was approached to ascertain about the details. Finally, on 18.6.2019, was issued roll number from the Enquiry Window and submitted a representation to the respondent-Commission for considering his name for scrutiny of documents.

I am afraid the aforementioned prayer is not acceptable as no plausible explanation has come forth for non-appearance of scrutiny of the documents except that roll number slip was lost. A person has to be diligent. It is not a case that all such persons could not avail the chance for scrutiny of documents. Had there been genuine ground and other exigencies, this Court would have definitely come to the rescue of petitioner.

No ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
