Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the officials respondents No.1 to 4 to independently enquiry into the allegations levelled against the petitioners by respondents No.5 to 7 and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7 as respondents No.5 to 7 are accused in FIR No.36 dated 23.6.2019.

2. Since the petitioners are helping the complainant in the FIR, respondents No.5 to 7 are having a grudge against the petitioners.

3. Reply by way of affidavit of Kamaljit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, on behalf of respondents No1, 3 and 4 has been filed. In paragraph 6 of the said reply, it is stated that on conducting the inquiry, the allegations levelled by respondent No.5 were not proved against petitioners and on account of dispute between the petitioner and respondents No.5 to 7, proceedings under Section 107/150 Cr.P.C have been initiated vide DDR No.37 dated 7.8.2019.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.
5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail alternate remedy with regard to his grievance relating to initiation of proceedings under Section 107/150 Cr.P.C.
